Communique: Fourth meeting of the Youth sub-group

Videoconference – 27 July 2021

On 27 July 2021, SETSCoP held its fourth meeting for members of the Youth sub-group. The meeting was co-hosted by Rana Ebrahimi (MYAN) and focused on training on the National Youth Settlement Framework (NYSF) in the context of SETS service delivery.

National Youth Settlement Framework (NYSF) Training

Responses received in the youth survey and collated snapshot, guided the focus for the training session. Respondents noted value in SETS specific training on the NYSF, as many had heard of the framework but requested training that specifically focuses on its application to SETS.

Linette Harriot (MYAN) ran the training on NYSF for youth sub-group members. Initially an overview of the framework and its usefulness was provided. Following this, the session focused on some reflective small group activities that were based on the Active Citizenship Domains (ACD) and the Good Practice Capabilities (GPC).

Within the first group activity, participants noted that digital literacy runs across all domains and that there was some overlap for relationships in the personal well-being and social participation domains. Despite some areas coming under certain domains, this emphasised the need for flexibility and an understanding that there is an interplay of factors across multiple domains.

Following the second group exercise, attendees discussed some practical ways of applying the GPC to their SETS work. One attendee shared how being more family-aware has been beneficial in their work with SETS clients as they have developed a more comprehensive understanding of the individual and the interplay of family dynamics and its impact on settlement success.

Next meeting

Positive feedback was received from providers on the usefulness of the session, with many seeing value in continuing the SETS-specific training into the next sub-group meeting. The next session will look at expanding on training and possibly delving deeper into the GPC with real life examples from SETS.
