

What is NAATI?

NAATI is the **national standards and certifying authority** for translators and interpreters in Australia.

It is the only organisation to issue certification to practitioners who wish to work in this profession in Australia.




Bilingual staff communicating with clients


Community Language Aide test

- Conducted **online** through a proctored platform
- Self-paced: flexibility over date and time of test
- Available in over 50 languages, including Auslan and indigenous languages
