• Chelsea King and Augusta Zeeng from the Centre for Multicultural Youth gave a presentation on the Schools Standing Up To Racism program.

Discussion overview

- The subgroup discussed racism and anti-racism programs.
- Implementing programs such as the Schools Standing Up To Racism program is a step by step process and is important to consider different approaches and have flexibility around implementing the program.
- Concerns around the increase in young people vaping in school environments and domestic violence amongst youth.
- Pressure of the rise in cost of living for parents filtering down to young people. Young people feeling the pressure to find work to contribute to the household.
- A SETS provider commented on communicating with young people about the importance of sports for mental and general wellbeing. The current FIFA Women's World Cup serving as a positive example for young women and in particular new arrivals.
