

# **Meeting Summary Communique**

#### **MYAN Updates:**

- 1. National Youth Conference upcoming: Canberra 27-28 November 2023. https://myan.org.au/sectorhub/myan-national-youth-conference/
- 2. Youth Settlement Policy Co-design Process ongoing. MYAN will provide update and further invitations to codesign workshops, feedback and validation process to the subgroup.
- 3. MYAN Annual Report being finalised for release within coming weeks

### **Discussion points:**

- Updates and sharing on SETS youth program models and activities
- Partner organisations and excursions including First Hike Project and ABC Radio
- Youth engagement a major topic of discussion: How to continue to improve youth engagement with programs and services. SETS providers engaging in continued promotion, outreach and networking (i.e. with schools and school principals
- Major theme: Youth want to connect socially with one another
- Programs that help young people access the city and also access nature
- Initiatives to support young people volunteering
- Overcoming the challenge that young people desire jobs but can struggle on essential skills such as CVs, cover letters, applications, and job readiness
- The importance of funding for arts, forms of activities for newly arrived young people. There has traditionally been a heavy focus on sports as an activity that brings people together, but arts is also a critical area. SETS providers shared examples of programs involving arts.
